At a Glance

Assistive Technology is only billable for IEP Medicaid students with an IEP.

- Must be listed in the IEP
- If an item, like a protection case, software, or app, is not listed in the IEP it is not eligible for reimbursement.
- Nothing disposable qualifies.

CPT CODE E1399



Is a billing code used for classification and reimbursement of "Durable Medical Equipment, Miscellaneous.

This is the billing code used for Durable Medical Equipment that does not have a specific code for the piece of equipment or supply being provided. This can be as simple as a walking cane or as elaborate as a customized wheelchair.

Required Documentation

1. Medicaid Members Individualized Education Plan (IEP) Within the Time Frame for The Date of Service
2. Copy of Original Receipt with Purchase Price and Item Name
3. Detailed Product Description (Printed from the Internet, such as online retailer or manufacture)

- If above documentation is present, force the edit and change EOB to 0640. Manual price the detail at billed amount.
